Under this program, Nanzan GLS offers a fully funded scholarship to eligible international students who pass the 2024 GLS entrance examination. The scholarship is an undergraduate scholarship of the Program for Training Sustainability Leaders in the Creating of an International Consortium.

The scholarship includes a monthly stipend, fee exemptions, and travel expense coverage as shown below. To be recommended for the scholarship, candidates must satisfy the following conditions of eligibility and requirements.

Eligibility	Candidates must be born on or after April 2nd, 1998 and have a nationality of ASEAN countries (Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar, or Laos).
Requirements	Japanese proficiency: JLTP N2 or higher
	English proficiency: CEFR B2 or higher
	Grade criteria: GPA 2.3 or higher
